**Heating Instructions:** Cheese cups are ready to eat from thaw and heating is optional.


Thaw Cups in refrigerator for 1-2 days prior use.

-Place Cups in Warmer covered with foil and heat to desired temp. between 135-150 degrees F

-Place thawed cups into Steamer for 10 minutes or until desired temperature between 135-150 degrees F.

-Place thawed cups in Hot Well covered and allow time to heat to desired temperature between 135 to 150 degrees F. **WARNING: Cups are not ovenable, do not use oven.**
